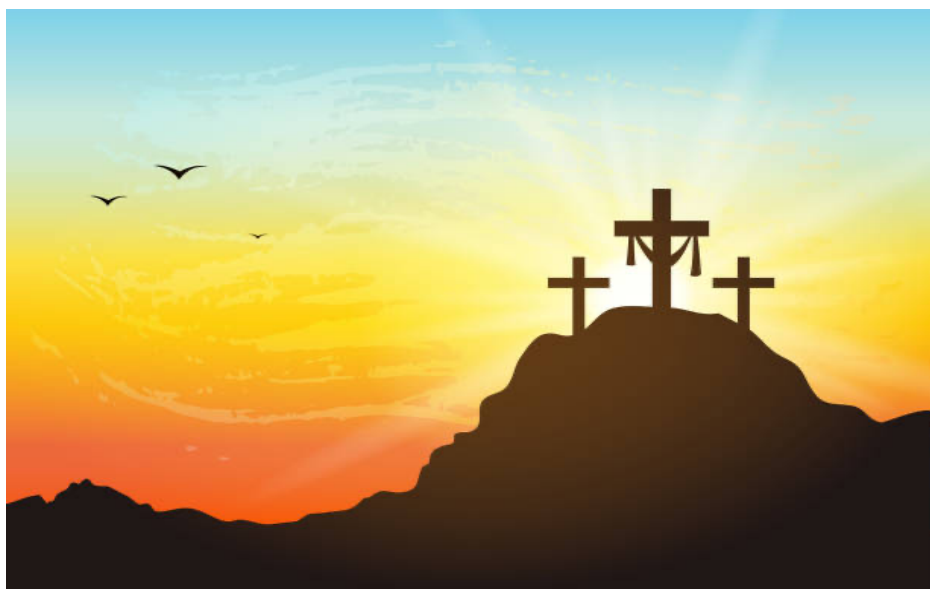

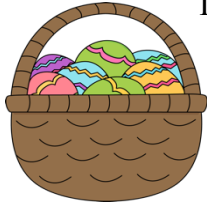

### **“Chiming In” w/ Pastor Sandy**

We recently began a new message series in the Gospel of Matthew titled *Kingdom Come*. Matthew's Gospel reveals Jesus as the long-awaited King who challenged his followers to a new way of living marked by humility, righteousness, and dependence on God.

During the season of Lent, the message of Jesus takes on great significance as we reflect upon his journey to the cross, repent of our sins and recommit to his Kingdom come. In Matthew, we see how Jesus called his disciples to lives of self-denial, faithfulness, and trust in God's provision. The teaching of Jesus remind us that the path to glory is through sacrifice and the way to true life is through surrender. *Kingdom Come* points us to the hope of Easter – the fulfillment of God's redemptive plan through Christ's death and resurrection. Just as Jesus proclaimed the arrival of God's Kingdom, his victory over sin and death secures our place in it when we follow him.

Wednesday, March 5<sup>th</sup> begins the Lenten season for 2025. Rather than just “giving up” something for 40 days, I encourage you to “give in” and “give all” to the Kingdom that has come and is coming.
