CHIMING IN WITH PASTOR SANDY

"And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him." (Hebrews 11:6)

Several years ago, I visited the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, New York. As a baseball fan, I was very interested in the exhibits, displays and artifacts telling the story of America's "National Pastime." After you walk the series of hallways, rooms and wings you end up in the plaque gallery where today a total of 333 former players, managers, executives and umpires are honored for their contributions to the game. The Hall of Fame opened in 1939 with the induction of five former players: Babe Ruth, Ty Cobb, Christy Mathewson, Honus Wagner and Walter Johnson. Even though that first induction ceremony was over 80 years ago, those first five inductees are still considered among the all-time greats in baseball history.

While there's no Christian "Hall of Fame," or none that I know of, the Bible has a chapter that's been nicknamed "The Hall of Faith." Hebrews chapter 11 provides a list of people from the Old Testament who are great examples of faith. Even though those people lived well over 3,000 years ago the story of their faith continues to inspire believers today.

Our current message series, "By Faith," surveys the individuals highlighted in Hebrews chapter 11, who are recorded throughout the Old Testament. The series reminds us there were real people long before us who endured the challenges of their times and continued to live by faith. None of us may never become known for having hall of fame faith, but it doesn't mean our faithful lives are less important than those recorded in Scripture. While we are facing unique challenges during our time, let's commit ourselves to living by faith.
