#### **FROM THE PASTOR**

For my Ask the Pastor Sunday this summer, I was presented with the question, when is Jesus coming again? What does the Bible say?" The second part of that question is the key. In all of my preaching and teaching and ministry, I try not to simply give opinions (of which I have many), but instead to carefully consider what the Bible says. The key Bible passages for understanding the Second Coming of Jesus Christ are Matthew 24-25, Mark 13, occasional references in the Letters and the book of the Revelation.

The Bible makes clear three points. **First,** Jesus <u>is</u> coming again. He said so. During his first coming he began his work of salvation and the establishment of his eternal kingdom. He ascended to heaven and continues his work through his church. When he returns he will complete and finish it. **Second**, we are to watch and be ready. Once again, those were Jesus' words. We are to look forward to, pray for, work toward, endure until and finally rejoice in the day of his coming.

Third, we will not know when until it happens. Again, that is what Jesus said. So, we are not to predict when or listen to anyone who does. Jesus will not come secretly or quietly this time, but it will be evident to all. Even though it has been 2,000 years already, the Bible says it will be soon. For each person, our time on earth is short, so we are to live as if the time is short and value each day and each moment. For God, who sees time differently, it will happen shortly in his time. The rest, ideas like rapture and The rest, ideas like rapture and millennium and tribulation and antichrist and other details have developed out of different interpretations of symbolic and figurative language. While they can be interesting and valuable to study and discuss, they tend to depend on minor and less clear or obscure passages. It is best to start with what is clear, and be more tentative and less dogmatic about the rest.
