FROM THE PASTOR

In my devotional time, I have been focusing on Jesus Christ. While that might seem obvious, in reality I often skip Jesus and go immediately to business- to asking and thanking and confessing and talking through situations, questions and fears. Instead, I am trying to take more time daily to focus more on seeing and understanding more clearly and deeply what it means to be with Christ and for him to be in me. Two images from the Revelation have been helpful.

John describes a vision of someone like a son of man walking among seven golden lampstands, which is Jesus in his churches (Revelation 1.13,20 and 2.1). As much as I would like to be self-sufficient in my Christian walk, I find I can't do it apart from the church. Jesus is present in his church. The worship, prayer, fellowship and Bible study with the church, and the help of some specific brothers and sisters in Christ, have been necessary and vital for me to follow and see and hear Christ. It is in relationship to one another that we grow in faith and faithfulness with Jesus Christ and He in us.

John also sees Jesus as the Amen (Revelation 3.14). We affirm our agreement and close our prayers in the name of Christ with Amen! Jesus is not only the beginning of all things and over all creation, He is the final word, faithful and true, the finisher! As Paul wrote, "He who began a good work in you will carry it to completion" (Philippians 1.6). I tend to think of Jesus as on the sidelines

watching while I am doing it all. Instead, the Amen, through his Holy Spirit is with me and in me through every moment and every action. We are in it together to the end. Amen!

Many thanks to members of the Clarksburg Community Church for the long time support you have given for my work on the Thai-Burma border. Over the last twelve years the Church has consistently contributed to provide medicines and supplies for women and children in rural Burma and also for women and children living with HIV/AIDS. The Mae Tao Clinic where I work when I am there has evolved from a humble health clinic into an important health training center and a social services network for refugees, migrant workers, and displaced ethnic Burmese and their children. My work has been mostly in the areas of reproductive health and childbirth, training health workers, preparing women to space their children and managing birth-related problems and complications. Over the years, many severe cases have been helped by the availability of basic medicine and proper care that would otherwise be unavailable.

Burma is a long way off from the quiet charm of Clarksburg, but despite that distance, a strong connection exists, a lifeline to those helped by the good will and kindness of those in this community.


30th ANNIVERSARY WINES OF CLARKSBURG – SEPTEMBER 16th
