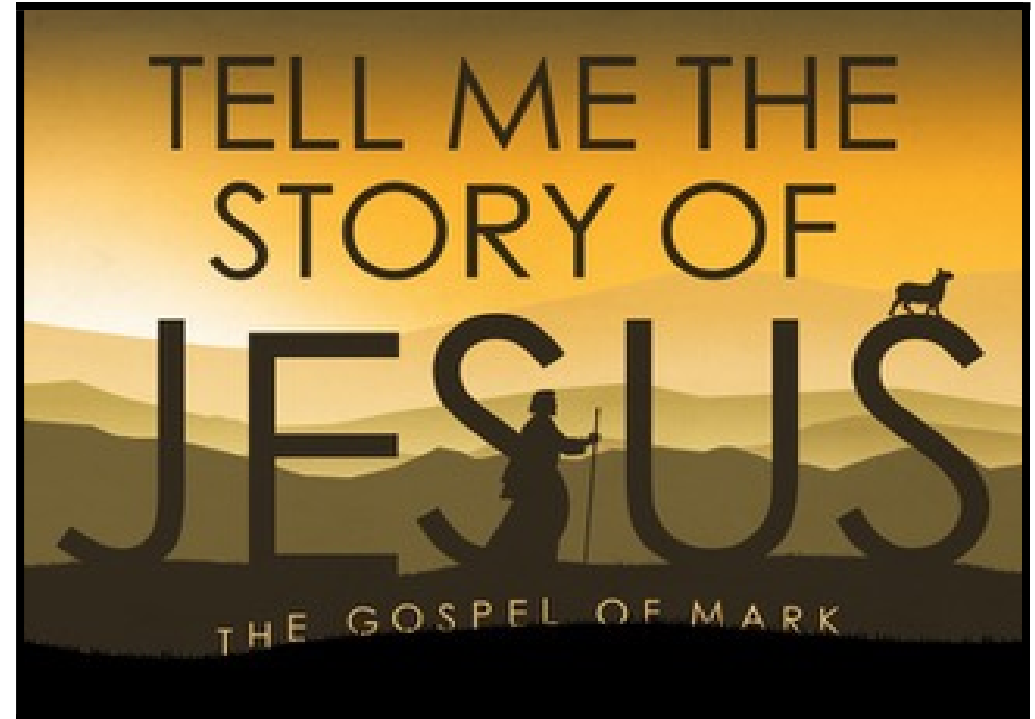

“What’s your story?” – have you ever been asked that? We all have one and they are probably more interesting than we think. However, out of all the personal stories in history the most fascinating and impactful one is that of Jesus of Nazareth – the first century Galilean Jew who has been believed to be the Son of God and Savior of the world by countless people for the past 2,000 years.

To understand the Christian faith is to understand the story of Jesus. The primary sources of Jesus’s story have been preserved and passed down to us in four individual works called “The Gospels.” Matthew, Mark, Luke and John were written within the first-generation following Jesus’s life on earth. More than likely, Mark was the first Gospel written and provides the shortest, most concise account of the life, ministry and teaching of Jesus.

Beginning March 8th, we will begin a series in the Gospel of Mark titled “Tell Me the Story of Jesus.” Because Mark is the earliest written record of Jesus, it is invaluable in helping us understand what his first followers believed about him and why his story made history.
