## CLARKSBURG LIBRARY SEPTEMBER EVENT-Owl Pellet Dissection



Have you ever wondered how Owls eat and process their food? Now is your chance to find out! Students will have an opportunity to dissect real owl pellets and discover what critters were consumed by these awesome nocturnal predators. Skull and bone charts as well as tweezers will be provided to help the students unlock the mysteries of each pellet. Students will work together to take apart owl pellets, sort through the animal bone graveyard that lies within each pellet and discover the mysterious remains of mice, rats, moles, snakes, lizards and even small birds. Students will have an opportunity to interact with a live bird and rodent during this session.
