2. What did Jesus mean in verse 10? What are you “thirsting” for? How has Jesus satisfied you?
3. How did the woman come to believe in Jesus? How did Jesus lead her to that point?  
How did the town come to believe in Jesus?  
How can we lead others to believe?
4. In verses 21-24, what does Jesus say about worship? How are you a “true” worshiper?  
When in your life have you experienced true worship?
5. What does Jesus mean in verses 32 and 34?  
How important is food to you?  
How important to you is doing God’s will?

1. In verses 1-15, what do we learn about the man who was healed? Why do you think Jesus asked, "Do you want to get well?" (verse 6), and later warned him to "stop sinning" (verse 14)?

2. In verses 16-30, what does Jesus say about himself and God the Father?  
How did the man who was healed experience what Jesus says about himself?  
When did you come to believe verse 24, and how have you experienced it in your life?
3. In verses 31-47, what witnesses does Jesus claim to support what he says about himself?  
How do we know Jesus was and is who he said he was?
