

### FROM THE PASTOR

In the past two weeks, Margie and I have experienced joy and sorrow, beginning and end, faith and Presence, and celebration and grief. Following closely on the birth of our granddaughter, Chloe, was the subsequent death of my mother, Eleanore. Our family gathering and Memorial Service in Seattle was a time of sorrow and grief because of our loss, but also full of joy and celebration for this woman of faith who gave a lifetime of life and love and faith, and for the abiding and living Presence of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ in whom we trust. At the heart of her service were three scriptures that express that faith:

You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand. -Psalm 16.11

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die;

and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?" -John 11.25-26

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. -Romans 8.38-39 Two days after her Memorial Service, I held 9 day old Chloe and knew that just as our Lord had given her life, by grace God has also given my mother eternal life. 
## ANNUAL CHURCH MEETING AND DINNER – NOVEMBER $5^{TH}$

### **REPORT ON THE NICARAGUA MISSION TRIP**

Pastor Dennis traveled to Nicaragua September 23-29 (Lee Harris was scheduled to go but had to cancel at the last minute) and joined the IBAC team four the four day institute in Esquipulas teaching the Biblical Doctrine of the Holy Spirit. The twice a year for seven years mission in Esquipulas began in April 2014, and we joined in April 2015, so this was the eighth institute (we have participated in six of them). We will continue to support and participate for three more years, through September 2020. We saw a tremendous jump this year in participants in the institute. Through September 2016 there were 45-60 participants from Esquipulas and immediate area churches. This past April that number went up to 85 and this September there were 135, and they came from up to 30 miles away (on limited, mountain roads). Even more important was the enthusiasm and hunger for biblical teaching, both for themselves personally and to take back to their churches. They set aside four full days from their normal schedules and work for this institute and intently followed every word of the lessons. It is a great joy and calling to bring God's Word to these people who so desperately long to hear.


